NOTICE OF RULES AND REGULATION REVISIONS CENTRAL OKLAHOMA MASTER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

The Central Oklahoma Master Conservancy District is the operator of Lake Thunderbird and associated raw water supply facilities. The Board of Directors of the Central Oklahoma Master Conservancy District proposed revisions to the Rules and Regulations of the District at its meeting held on December 4, 2014. The rules and regulations, if approved in final form by the District Board of Directors, will include provisions for prohibiting:

- Interference with District operations
- Trespassing, unlawful entry, use of unauthorized vehicles or other unauthorized use of project property, and unauthorized entry of livestock
- Damage to the works of the project, soil erosion of project property, or otherwise adversely affecting the District project works
- Obstruction of access to the project works by the District, or obstructing an easement
- Pollution on the property of the project, or violation of existing erosion control requirements of the state, federal, or municipal governments
- Unlawful dumping
- Unlawful discharge of pollutants, or unlawful construction of a wastewater system within the Lake Thunderbird watershed
- Construction or operation of certain sewage disposal systems, or discharge of pollutants into the watershed, except with prior notice to the District and compliance with all applicable laws
