

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Central Oklahoma Master Conservancy District (COMCD) is currently soliciting Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) for architectural and engineering services to perform a feasibility level evaluation of selected sites for free surface water flow wetlands for the removal of contaminants of emerging concerns (CECs) and other pollutants. This project is to be financed by funds from the Environmental Protection Agency made available through a Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB) and is referred to as Project No. ORF-23-0095-CW.
